Background:

Ituro exist, as most of the elderly people in the community do not have a place to stay. They are often staying with their children or grandchildren who neglect or abuse them physically, psychologically and emotionally. Some of the elderly are homeless. They are temporarily hospitalised at the community hospital and desperately need a home. The elderly people need to be protected from any type of abuse. They need to be

treated with dignity and respect. They need educational services, sound relationships and some form of entertainment.

Objectives:

- To educate members of the community about the needs and concerns of the older citizens,
- To provide the elderly with accommodation or shelters where they can socialise,
- To link the elderly with other service providers,
- To empower them by providing education which will strengthen their knowledge.

Odirile Mentally and Physically Disabled Children Centre

Odirile is based in Temba and they supply housing and schooling for physically and mentally disabled children. They promote conditions in society favorable to stable family life and promotion of children especially the mentally handicapped children.

The building they are using at the moment is an old bottle store and the building desperately needs attention. There are no baths; only toilets and the children are bathed in tubs with water. There are 100 children, aged between 5 years and 29 years. The staff that works there does not receive a salary and do it for the love of it. Their biggest problem is food and the building as it is a risk. The parents are also struggling to supply the children with their daily needs, so clothes and other daily needs are also very welcome.
